INFORMATION REGARDING DILATING DROPS

Dilating drops are used to dilate or enlarge the pupils of the eye to allow the ophthalmologist to get a better view of the inside of your eye. It is necessary to dilate both of your eyes today to get an adequate exam of your retina.

Dilating drops frequently blur your vision for a length of time that varies from person to person and may make your eyes sensitive to lights. It is not possible for Dr. Jayne to know exactly how the dilating drops will affect your vision. Because driving may be difficult after the drops and an examination, it's best if you make arrangements not to drive yourself for the remainder of the day. You will need to wear sunglasses after the examination, if you did not bring your own sunglasses please ask for a pair and we will provide them for you.

Adverse reactions such as acute angle closure glaucoma can occur after dilating drops are instilled in your eye. This is rare and needs to be treated with drops or possible laser treatment. Let Dr. Jayne know if you experience eye pain after your eyes are dilated.
